The Foundation contributes to the personal development of young people by encouraging them to participate in social responsibility projects as volunteers. In doing so, it increases young people's community involvement on a voluntary basis.</p> <p>Community Volunteers Foundation;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Trains trainers who implement peer to peer trainings on subjects such as volunteerism, project management, human rights, social rights, reproductive health, health literacy and organizational management• Offers face to face support to university student clubs according to their needs• Provides scholarship opportunities and internships to young people• Creates a learning environment that increases youth mobility, which in turn supports learning from other young people and youth organizations

Toplum Gonulluleri Vakfi (TOG) believes in the realization of social peace, solidarity and change through the participation and leadership of the youth with the assistance of adults who believe in the synergy of youth.

Our purpose is to contribute to the formation of a youth with social awareness and self-esteem and to develop and realize various social service, social awareness and advocacy projects and to transform the energy of youth towards social benefit by having the principles based on impartiality (respect to differences during all activities -cultural diversity-, no segregation based on religious, ideological, political views or ethnicity), transparency and accountability, democratic, local participation, teamwork (the understanding of 'all together for all of us'), entrepreneurship, learning through experiencing.

TOG network includes over 111 youth student clubs in 56 cities all around Turkey in 104 universities, 157 projects and more than 35000 volunteers all over Turkey. The volunteers are mostly university students between the ages of 17-30. Social responsibility, social awareness and advocacy projects are implemented by young volunteers organized as student clubs in the universities of Turkey. All these projects are mainly planned and run by young community volunteers. The TOG Office supports the projects; partly funds the projects or helps to raise the fund for them; communicates with public and press, and empowers the young volunteers with trainings, traineeships, grants, and mentorship.

TOG was also part of youth centers for assisting young refugees. This project aimed to strengthen the refugees and assist their process of harmonization, by strengthening the ties between 15 to 30 years old refugees and Turkish youngsters. In the youth center various activities like art and culture workshops, language courses, history works, sport activities, peer trainings and many more were performed. The centers also ensured the young refugees with health services and providing information about sexual health and reproduction. The youth centers were located in Ankara, Diyarbakir, Hatay and Izmir.
